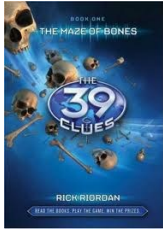

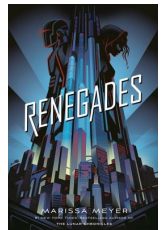

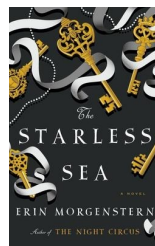
Stormbreaker : an Alex Rider Adventure by Anthony Horowitz
