Shirley and Jamila save their summer

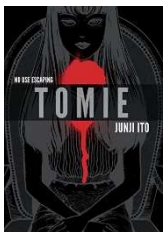

Lifetime passes

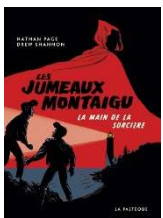

Tomie: No use escaping

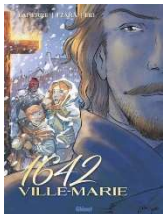

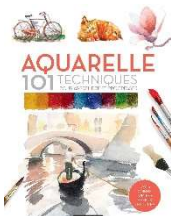

plaisir et de rester motivé !

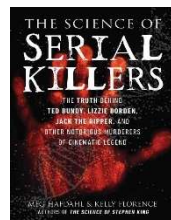

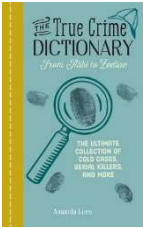
